This program is hosted by the Doug-Fir District to assist boys in Scouting Units meet merit badge counselors and introduce them to the merit badge process. The program is broken down into two sessions in order to provide the boy and counselor an opportunity to follow up on the merit badge work. Each session will be held at the LDS Church at 2001 W. Bertha St. in Roseburg, on the hill off of Harvard, except Swimming, which will be at the YMCA.

It is the responsibility of each boy to obtain a Merit Badge Application from his unit leader and present it to the counselor at the first session. It is also the responsibility of each Scout to call and register for this program.
