Dress and Grooming Standards

As a member of the Camp Staff of the Oregon Trail Council, Boy Scouts of America, ____I understand that I must meet the dress and grooming standards to model to campers and guests the uniform method of Scouting.

- Official Boy Scout uniforms are to be worn at all official camp ceremonies such as flags, campfires, chapel services, and other times designated by the Camp Director.
- Uniforms are to be official issue and worn properly.
- Haircuts for male staff are to be conservative. Dyed hair in unnatural colors and extreme hair styles will not meet standards.
- Jewelry should be conservative, tasteful, and limited to:
Men: wedding rings and watches
Women: wedding rings, watches, and one pair of small earrings.
- No facial hair may exist below the middle of the ear except for a neatly trimmed mustache or beard currently existing on first day of camp. Camp Director reserves the right to request any staff member to shave at any time.
